# Three Turnings

- God turns Jonah back to Himself.
- God turns the Ninevites back to His glory.
- God turns from wrath to mercy.

#### Turn One:

- From fugitive to deputy
- From the Gates of Hell to the Gates of Nineveh

#### Turn Two:

- From ISIS to believing
- From barbaric acts to fearing God

## Turn Three:

- From God's wrath to God's compassion
- From destruction to forgiveness

## Matthew 12:40

For as Jonah was three days and three night in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

## Jonah as a Sign

- Three days in the fish foreshadows Jesus in the tomb
- Jonah's rebellion mirrors the resistance of Israel to God
- Jonah's mission illustrates God's love for the nations.

- restored Calling
