Key Word: Consider (Your Ways)

- Haggai 2
- Haggai 1:4, 8
- Haggai 2:7, 9

Time Line

- 536 BC – 1st return under Zerubbabel & Joshua
- 535 BC – work on Temple begins & halts
- 520 BC – Sep 1 Haggai's first call to build
- 520 BC – Sep 24 Work resumes
- 15 year halt in construction
- Discouragement; Indifference; Apathy
- The Dynamic Duo

Message 1: Consider Your Ways & Complete My Temple

- Haggai 1:4 "Why isn't God's house first?"
- Haggai 1:8 "Go up to the mountain, & bring wood, & build the house ... & I will be glorified, saith the LORD."

Message 2: Consider the Future Glory of My Temple

- Haggai 2:6-9
- "...I will shake the heavens, & the earth... I will shake all nations, & the Desire of all nations shall come: & I will fill this house with glory... The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former..."

Message 3: Consider Your Blessings from the Completion of My Temple

- Haggai 2:14
- "...& so is every work of their hands; & that which they offer there is unclean."
- Isaiah 64:6 & Romans 8:8
- Haggai 2:18-19
- "Consider now from this day & upward... Even from the day that the foundation of the LORD's temple was laid, consider it... From this day will I bless you."
